THU 10/6: Ted Gahl's "Night Painting" at DODGEgallery, 15 Rivington Street, 6 - 8 p.m., through November 13, dodge-gallery.com

Gahl's abstract canvases, brushed thinly and reminiscent of early Jackson Pollock and Mark Rothko, are about "the experience of painting at night," "about subjects that arise in the unfettered quiet and solitude of nighttime." The work's dark-yet-luminous colors and high modernist tone bring about a deep sense of artistic nostalgia and interior reflection.
